

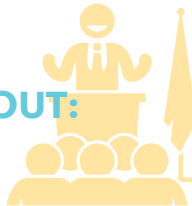
Political Participation Activities

1. THE TWITTERING CLASSES: ONLINE DISCUSSION

3. TAKING IT TO THE STREETS: ACTIVISM



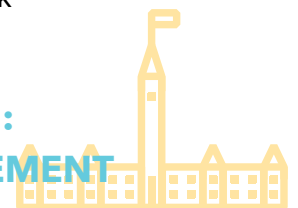
- I signed a petition
